This trip is an exciting hands on education & fun filled experience for the students at **Imagica theme park, Khopoli and Monteria resort, Khopoli** offering fun and action entertainment. These are the places where students will feel the adrenaline rush & swirl in the craziest rides.

Days and dates: Wednesday 16th & Thursday 17th October 2019

05.45PM: Arrival at Monteria resort, Khopoli and settle down, followed by room allocation, free time for ground games

08.00 PM: Dinner at Monteria Resort (01 nonveg item, 01 veg soup, Veg fried rice, Veg Hakka, noodles, Manchurian gravy, Chinese salad, Fruit custard)

9.00PM-10.00PM: DJ Music

10.00 PM: Light off

DAY 02:

07.00 AM: Wakeup call, Activity

08.30 AM: Breakfast at Monteria Resort (Idli Sambhar chutney, Poha, Bread, butter, jam, Tea and coffee, Egg counter)

09.30 AM-12.30 PM: **Enjoy adventure activities- Vertical Net, Log to Log, Rail Track, Swinging Plank, Tyre Bridge, Zig Zag Plank, Bucket Net, Burma Bridge, Burma Loop, V Log, Space Walk, Horizontal Net, Wooden Obstacle & team building games**

01.00PM - 2.00PM: Lunch at Monteria Resort (Jeera aloo , Veg handi, Dal, Rice, Roti, Papad, Pickle, Gulabjamun, Chicken masala)

02.00PM - 04.30PM: Visit to NAB (National Association for Blind) & Chikki factory

05.00 PM: Leave for School by bus

07.00 PM: Arrival at school. (Depending upon the traffic)

Dress code: School Uniform along with PT Uniform & I card compulsory.

General Instructions for picnic:

- As 16, 17 October 2019 are non instructional days, those students who have not enrolled for the field trip will have holiday.
- Kindly fill the undertaking form given in the School diary (Calendar) (Page No. 147/149) and submit the same in school along with the trip cost.
- All the material sent along with the students should be properly labeled.
- School transport facility will not be available on the said day.
- Students should not carry any Jewellery, electronic gadgets and any valuable articles.
- Kindly do not send the student for the educational tour if he / she is unwell.
- Charges for the trip will not be refunded.
- Each student is permitted to carry only one cabin baggage/Hand luggage (22 inches x 18 inches approx) and one "soft" carry-on bag (shoulder bag).
- Parents are required to check all luggage before bringing it to school to ensure the proper type of clothing for night out i.e. night dress, Sweater / jacket, Scarves, Cap and toiletries like tooth brush, tooth paste, sanitizer/ hand wash, hair brush or comb etc. have been packed.
- We are relying upon parents to supervise the packing process to ensure students do not bring items that may violate the school's code of conduct or dress code.
- Luggage should have identification tags and be clearly marked.
- Students will be expected to carry their own luggage to the bus and to their rooms at the hotel.
- Main luggage will be stowed beneath the bus; therefore, students will not have access to them during travel time. Anything needed during the day should be packed in the carry-on bag.
- Glass bottles / glass crockery items are not permitted on the buses.
- Parent discretion is advised before handing over any amount of money to the students to spend during the field trip. Students will be responsible for the handling of their money.

Behaviour / Discipline

- Parents are requested to emphasize the importance of responsibility and courteous behavior in their wards.
- We expect and will accept only excellent behavior from all students throughout the trip as they are the representatives of City International School, Aundh.
- To bring the sense of the responsibility and self discipline in the students, such field trips are organized. Every student is expected to maintain cleanliness in the bus/ public place/ hotel and handle the things in the hotel room, bus or the places visited etc. with utmost care without causing any breakage or damage to any public property/ hotel/ room in any manner to avoid the inconvenience.
- Students must realize travelling in a large group is different than when travelling with the family. Decisions are made and instructions are given with the safety and concern of the entire group in mind so the students must maintain their conduct so as not to cause discomfort to anyone and always abide rules or instructions given by the teachers/co-ordinators.

Trip Cost: 5000/-Rs. (Include - Transport, toll, parking, Imagica entry, all meals, adventure activities, music, everyday 1 water bottle).

The amount will be collected by the class teacher along with the Undertaking Form till **11th October 2019**. Please ensure that you send the **exact amount in an envelope duly labeled with the name of the student, grade and division**. Amount will not be accepted after the due date.
